



How the Summer Reading 2022 program works:

- *Children must be registered in the grade they are going into.
- *All grades have a designated day and range of time they can participate. Check the calendar for those days and times.
- *Once registered, each participant(birth-3rd Grade) will receive a bag containing a folder. That folder contains everything the participant needs for the summer.
- *The folder contents will include, calendars, reading logs and program information.
- *Replacement folders WILL NOT be available.

Reading Logs:

- *Each child will have two reading lists in their folder. Additional ones are available. There is no limit.
- *Each reading list contains multiple reading logs.
- *One book title will be written on each line and when you get to a star, that completes one reading log.
- *A prize will be awarded for each of the first 5 reading logs completed. A ticket for the drawings will be given for ALL completed reading logs.
- *Participants MUST read books in their reading level. If your child is reading above or below their grade level, speak to me and things can be adjusted.

- *On their designated day, participants will work their way through three activity/craft stations and a reading station(birth-3rd). Older participants will have planned activities for their day(4th-12th grade).
- *A ticket for the drawing will be awarded for each station completed that day.

- *Tweens/Teens have designated days and times as well. .
- *Tweens/Teens will receive reading lists as well. They will be awarded a prize for each of the first 5 reading logs completed as well as a ticket for the drawings.

There will be 3 Family programs on the Fridays in July. Check your calendars for who will be here.

The drawing for all Summer Reading prizes will be Friday, July 29th.
